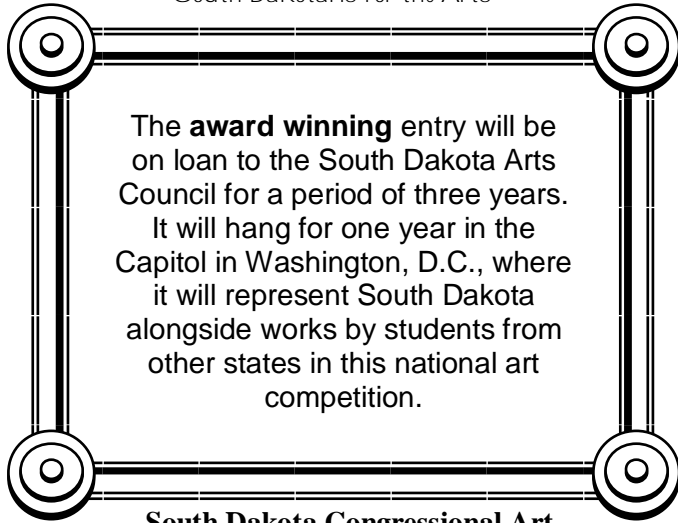

COMPETITION GUIDELINES

- ? Competition open to high school students only.
- ? Artwork must be two-dimensional only,
no larger than
28" x 28" UNFRAMED
within the following categories:

PAINTINGS

oil, acrylic, watercolor, etc.

DRAWINGS

pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers

COLLAGES

must be two dimensional

PRINTS

lithographs, silk-screens, block prints

COMPUTER GENERATED ART

PHOTOGRAPHY

MIXED MEDIA

- ? **Entry must be an original concept:** the work may not violate U.S. Copyright Law. The winning student and his/her teacher must sign a release certifying originality of the artwork. **Any entry reproduced from an existing photo, painting or other existing work WILL NOT be accepted.**
- ? **Final decision regarding suitability** for exhibition in the Capitol is left to the discretion of a panel of qualified persons chaired by the Architect of the Capitol.
- ? **Submit UNFRAMED artwork with name, return address and indication of medium on back and send to:**
